

# MEET HOLLY BERRY

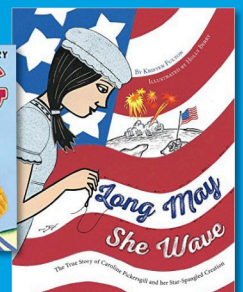
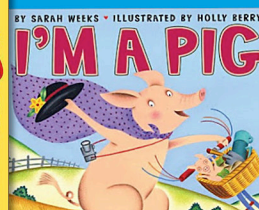
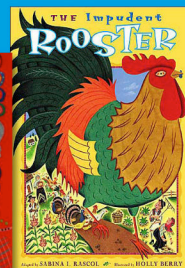
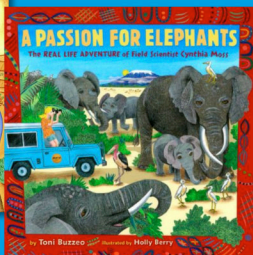
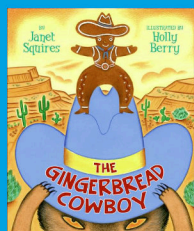
*"Try to think of the illustration as a way to move readers through the story. How can one page lead you to the next?"*

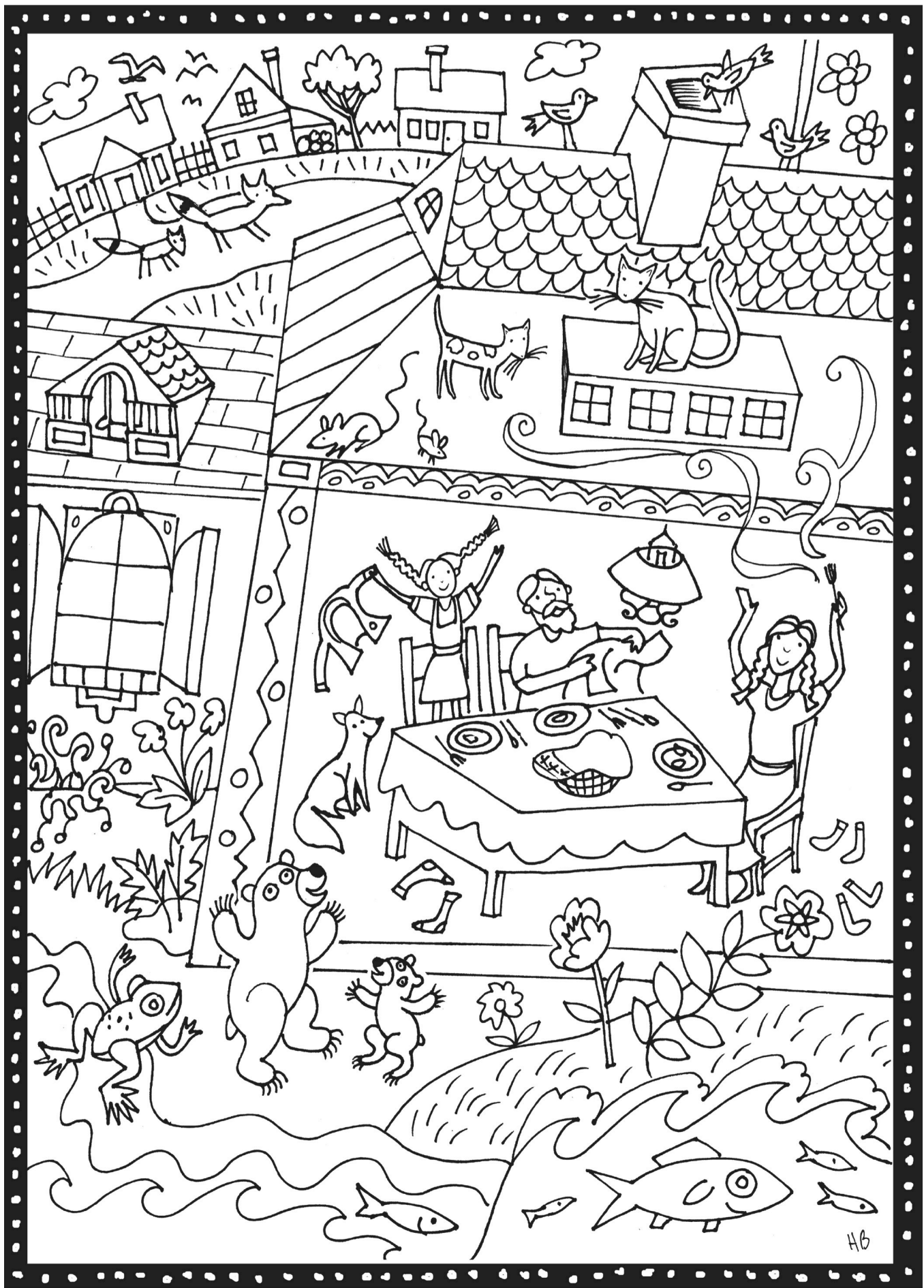
