



School Tours at Treehouse

2024-2025

Bring your students and Step into a Story® at Treehouse Children's Museum! Our tours are designed with learning in mind and offer unique literature, art, and theater activities – centered around the Museum's award-winning exhibits. On your tour, students will share an interactive storytelling, star in a ParticiPlay® in our Simmons Storybook Theater, do a themed visual art project in our Art Garden, and spend time exploring our exhibits while supervised by their adult chaperones.









Treehouse can accommodate school groups of 15 to 110 students. Groups larger than 40 students may be divided among up to three tour guides.

School groups are asked to bring 1 adult for every 5 students as a chaperone who actively supervises children throughout the visit.

Because Treehouse is open to the public during tour times, groups who do not provide an enough chaperones to adequately supervise their students will not be able to have free exploration time and their tour will be shorter.

Cost for schools with a reservation is \$6 per student and teachers and chaperones are free. Please note that Treehouse Membership Cards are NOT valid on School Tours since payment is in bulk and discounted.

School tours can be scheduled Tuesdays through Fridays. The morning tour time is 9:30 a.m. 11:30 a.m. and afternoon time is 12 to 2 p.m.

Treehouse Tour Themes



FAIRY TALES: Your students will discover the magic of the stories from the Brothers Grimm, Charles Perrault, and other authors from around the world. The perfect fit for Kindergarten through 3rd Grade.



HOMETOWN HEROES: Meet us on Main Street for a focus on the contributions of local heroes and community helpers, as we meet the citizenship and community objectives of the State Core. *Perfect for Kindergarten through 2nd Grade*.



WALK IN THE WOODS: Take your students into the Woods at Treehouse to learn about Utah plants and animals, seasonal changes in the natural world, and discover who lives in the pond, in the cave, and in the summer meadow.

Recommended for K through 2nd Grade.



WORLD TALES: In the One World Village Gallery at Treehouse your students will explore the stories that children in several countries know and love.

Recommended for 2nd Grade and up.



UTAH TALES: We've got the biggest map of Utah around. Your students will take a look at our state's heritage and geography, surrounded by our Barn, Farmhouse, Rodeo Arena, One Room Schoolhouse, and our Native American artifact collection. Recommended for 2nd Grade and up.



STAR SPANGLED AMERICAN TALES: Team up with Treehouse to learn about our unique form of government. Your students will print their own copies of the Declaration of Independence on our Independence Press and explore all 50 states on the Great American Map. Students will love the Tall Tale Participlay® in our Storybook Theater, too. *Recommended for 3rd Grade and up*.



HOLIDAYS OF LIGHT: Explore holiday traditions from around the world through art, theater, and story. Available exclusively from Tuesday, November 12 through Friday. December 20 in 2024.

Recommended for 1st through 5th Grades.
